Privacy Statement

1. DTS's commitment to maintaining your privacy

DTS's Privacy Statement has been created because we value our users and recognise their right to keep personal information private. This statement discloses our information gathering and distribution practices for all sites managed by DTS.

2. Collecting information on DTS visitors / job seekers

DTS collects information on our site visitors collectively including which sections of the site are most frequently visited, how often and for how long. This data is always used as aggregated, non-personal information. DTS utilises this information to improve and enhance our services by monitoring the areas on the site which are most popular to you. This aggregated information may be shared with DTS partners to provide them with an overview of how DTS visitors use the site. This is done for the purposes of providing you with the best online career management services.

IP Addresses

DTS's web servers gather your IP address to assist with the diagnosis of problems or support issues with our services. Again, information is gathered in aggregate only and cannot be traced to an individual user.

Cookies & Applets

DTS utilises cookies to provide you with a better user experience. These cookies and 'applets' allow you to utilise specific services such as Job Mail (an alert service which provides you with emails specific to your requirements).

Users who do not wish to receive cookies can instruct their web browsers to refuse them. However, doing so will prevent access to some areas of the site and limit your use of some of the DTS services.

Tracking and Measurement

In order to better understand our users, DTS utilises a tracking code is used to collect the following information on the usage of the DTS site:

- The number of page views (or page impressions) that occur on DTS;
- The number of unique visitors to DTS;
- How long these unique visitors (on average) spend on DTS when they do visit; and
- Common entry and exit points into DTS.

This aggregate, non-personal information is collated by DTS to assist in analysing the usage of the site.

3. Email communications from DTS

From time to time, DTS may provide you with information about best practice activities in the security industry. This free service is available on this site to all users.

DTS may also make you aware of additional products and services which form part of your relationship with DTS.

4. Storage & Security of Personal Information

DTS takes all reasonable steps to ensure the security of our system. DTS allows you to access your information at any time to keep it accurate and up to date. Any information which we hold for you is stored on secure servers that are protected in controlled facilities.

In addition, our employees and the contractors who provide services related to our information systems are obliged to respect the confidentiality of any personal information held by DTS. However, DTS will not be held responsible for events arising from unauthorised access of your personal information.

You can also play an important role in keeping your personal information secure, by maintaining the confidentiality of any password and accounts used on the DTS site. 5. Access to Your Information

As indicated in point 2, unless you become a registered 'DTS Members' user, DTS does not collect information that identifies you personally.
